



Information concerning flood damage in Thailand
(October 19, 2011)

This is to report our company's situation at this point with regards to the flood damage in various places of Thailand.

Further flooding and how our clients and suppliers are affected by it may have an impact on our operations. We will be closely monitoring the situation and will take what appropriate actions are necessary for future operations.

1. Damage situation

At our consolidated subsidiary in Thailand, Thai Engineering Products Co., Ltd., flooding into the plant was confirmed on October 18 and the plant is currently shut down. Damage to buildings, equipment, etc. is currently being investigated. There is no damage to buildings, facilities, etc. of our other production companies across the country. These production companies are operating according to the situations of their clients.

There is no human damage reported at any of our group companies.

2. Impact on our performance

The impact of this flood damage on our performance, etc. is currently under investigation. If a significant impact is anticipated, we will promptly inform you.

3. Future responses

We will continue to collect information on flood damage and its impact on our performance. As for future operations, we will take appropriate actions including the examination of production alternatives, while coordinating closely with our clients and suppliers.
