Information concerning flood damage in Thailand (second report)
(November 18, 2011)

Our company's current situation on flood damage in Thailand is reported below.

1. Damage situation

At our consolidated subsidiary in Thailand, Thai Engineering Products Co., Ltd. (hereinafter referred to as "TEP") flooding into the plant was confirmed on October 18 and the plant is currently shut down. However, as drainage started at Industrial Estate on November 18, the company is now promoting recovery efforts so as to restart operations at the earliest.

Note that none of our group companies except for TEP suffered flood or other damage.

2. Company responses

We have taken measures to alternate production in response to the TEP shutdown. Our plant in Japan started alternating production. Also, we joined hands with Thailand and other overseas bases of our global production system to supply automobile parts to customers.

3. Impact on our performance

The impact of this flood damage on our performance, etc. is currently under investigation. If a significant impact is anticipated, we will promptly inform you.
