Information concerning flood damage in Thailand (third report)
(December 22, 2011)

Our company's current situation on flood damage in Thailand is reported below.

1. Damage situation

At our consolidated subsidiary in Thailand, Thai Engineering Products Co., Ltd. (hereinafter referred to as "TEP") flooding into the plant was confirmed on October 18, since which time the plant has been shut down. However, as drainage, cleaning and equipment restoration in the plant have been completed, the company has partially restarted its operations from December 22. Aisin Group companies, mainly in Japan and Thailand, have taken measures to alternate production in response to the TEP shutdown. Now, along with the restart of operations in TEP, we plan to gradually return to a normal production system.

2. Impact on our performance

The impact of this flood damage on our performance, etc. is currently under investigation. If a significant impact is anticipated, we will promptly inform you.
