

Frequently Asked Questions about the com-center

Q : What are your hours?

A : We are open from 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM.
(Admission until 4:30 PM)

Q : Is it necessary to make a reservation in advance?

A : No reservations are required in advanced. Feel free to visit the facility at any time.

Q : How long does it take to see the exhibits?

A : Between 1 hour and 90 minutes is sufficient to see everything at a leisurely pace.

Q : In what order should I see the different zones?

A : Corporate Zone → (Theater*) → History Zone → "Monozukuri" Zone
→ Projection Mapping Theater → Products Zone → AISIN Group's vision of the future → Lifestyle and Energy Zone

*If you would like to see a film about Aisin Group, you need a reservation in advance.

Q : Is photography permitted?

A : Feel free to take photos in the com-center.

Q : Do I need a reservation to see the Projection Mapping display in advance?

A : You do not need a reservation in advance. Feel free to see it anytime.
(The display lasts approximately 6 minutes.)

Q : Can non-Japanese visitors enjoy the exhibits?

A : At the com-center, information is provided in Japanese, English, and Chinese.

Q : Can I check my luggage or belongings?

A : Free coin-operated lockers are available for use.
