# Frequently Asked Questions about the com-center

## **Q**: What are your hours?

A: We are open from 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM. (Admission until 4:30 PM)

## **Q**: Is it necessary to make a reservation in advance?

A : No reservations are required in advanced. Feel free to visit the facility at any time.

## Q: How long does it take to see the exhibits?

A : Between 1 hour and 90 minutes is sufficient to see everything at a leisurely pace.

## **Q**: In what order should I see the different zones?

A: Corporate Zone  $\rightarrow$  (Theater\*)  $\rightarrow$  History Zone  $\rightarrow$  "Monozukuri" Zone  $\rightarrow$  Projection Mapping Theater  $\rightarrow$  Products Zone  $\rightarrow$  AISIN Group's vision of the future  $\rightarrow$  Lifestyle and Energy Zone

### Q: Do I need a reservation to see the Projection Mapping display in advance?
