Shared Shuttle Bus Service Implemented on Trial Basis in Toyoake, Aichi

Aisin Seiki and Sugi Holdings Co., Ltd. (Head Office: Obu, Aichi, President: Katsunori Sugiura), with the backing of the Toyoake City Health and Longevity Section, will launch a mobility support service aimed at maintenance and promotion of health on July 24, 2018 in the city's Senninzuka area on a trial basis, targeting all residents of the area but especially elderly people.


As Japan's population ages, the increase in shopping-challenged individuals has become a social problem, and it is also difficult for these same people to receive appropriate medical care and medication guidance because of their difficulty in visiting facilities on their own. These people can be considered "medically challenged."

To address this issue, we will offer a shared shuttle-bus service that gives people in the community access to medical institutions, public facilities, fitness opportunities, supermarkets and so forth. The goal is to deliver appropriate medical treatment, medication guidance and general health consultations, and to create an environment where people can freely go out for social activities and shopping.
